Open to all 1st - 12th Grade Teachers and Teaching Teams throughout Georgia that exemplify STEM efforts in the classroom!

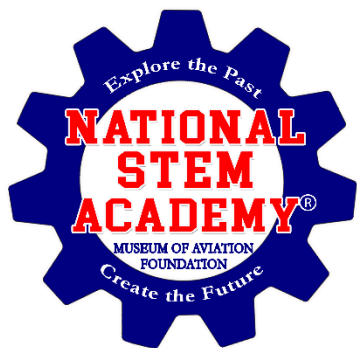

The winners will be announced in August 2019 during the Georgia NASA STEM Conference!

\$1,000 cash prize will be awarded to each winning category.

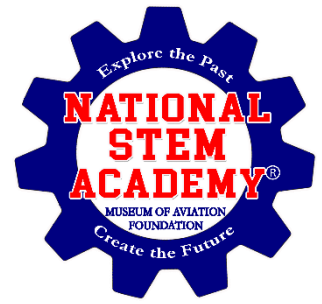

Award Guidelines



- ❁ Nominee(s) must be a 1st - 12th grade teacher.
- ❁ Nominee(s) must be from a Georgia School District; public or private.
- ❁ Teachers can nominate themselves, however they must include a letter of support and/or reference information from a direct supervisor.
- ❁ Winners will be notified of Award on or before the NASA STEM Conference in August 2019. Award will be in the form of a cash prize! \$1,000.00 awarded to each winning teacher or each winning team of teachers! Teams will split Award. Award winners or a representative must be in attendance for the Georgia NASA STEM Conference at The Museum of Aviation to receive award plaque and checks in August 2019.
- ❁ Nominators must explain clearly and in detail how the nominee(s) is/are using STEM efforts in the classroom and provide a 2-3 minute video or 5-10 slide PowerPoint Presentation, with photos. All self-nominations must be accompanied by a letter of support /reference from a supervisor or principal.
