

COVID19 Safety Policies

The National STEM Academy at the Museum of Aviation has implemented additional measures to mitigate the risks associated with COVID-19.

Safety Measures include:

- Follow Executive Orders set by the Office of Governor Kemp.
- Follow CDC Guidelines for Youth Programs.
- Follow Georgia Department of Education Pandemic Policy.
- Provide staff with training in how to reduce risks of getting sick, recognize symptoms of COVID-19 and promote/monitor safe hygiene practices around the Museum and its classrooms.
- Maintain an Infectious Disease Policy/Staff Manual.
- Provide a PPE Supply Station in Eagle Building, Space & Innovation Center and Century of Flight Building. Provide staff with easy access to digital thermometers for temperature checks as needed/required.
- Classroom Capacities are carefully figured/posted based on square footage, movement, and furniture. Arrange classrooms for appropriate physical distancing.
- Provide hand-washing facilities and hand sanitizer gel.
- Enhance cleaning and disinfecting regimens in all facilities. Name a Sanitation Monitor for each program and event.
- Provide masks and gloves for all staff to be worn as needed based on distancing requirements and activity.
- Provide masks (additional charge) for students if they arrive without appropriate mask protection and to be worn as needed based on distancing requirements.
- Design activities, lessons, and tours to incorporate safe practices.
